International Facility Certification Applications

Are practices outside of the United States eligible?

Yes! We have facilities that are certified outside of the United States. There may be some distinct differences in certifying bodies, credentials, products, and approved medications available. It is encouraged before submission to email a letter or get in contact with certification@veccs.org to discuss any differences that may arise during the application process that may prohibit immediate approval.

Additionally, facilities outside of the United States or any ECVECC applicable regions will be asked to provide a resume for doctors practicing within their facility. This document should include school attended, any specialized continuing education for their applied specialty such as internships, and any additional certification that involved veterinary medicine and that doctor's scope of practice or area of expertise.

We also ask that any medical records be translated into English if possible. If not, please email certification@veccs.org for further instruction.
